


Online self assessment platform for ADN training

The European Agreement concerning the International Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Inland Waterway (ADN) aims at ensuring a high level of safety of international carriage of dangerous goods by inland waterways. The ADN regulations also address the issue of certificates of approval, recognition of classification societies, monitoring, as well as training and examination of experts. When

dangerous substances are carried on board a vessel, an expert with special knowledge of ADN must be on board. Proof of this knowledge must be provided by means of a certificate issued by the competent authority or a body authorized by it.

For individual learners, an online self assessment tool will be adopted by all countries to support preparation for the certificate examination. The self assessment is based on the catalogue of questions provided by UNECE and follows the same directives applied for the certification examination.

The online platform to be set up can be adopted by national authorities to support the certification process with the creation of regulations in compliance with the exam questionnaire, administration tools for certificates, training and examination dates and examination experts.



Case Studies



Two case studies will be developed for training on the topic of cargo transport solutions which enable individual and team learning for understanding the differences between transport modes. The application of the case studies can be adopted for training of undergraduate and graduate students with a focus on logistics, business and administration.
